

- The Southminster Presbyterian Church Foundation was established in 1979 with a generous gift of \$250,000 from a Southminster member
- All church members are members of the Southminster Foundation
- Since inception (1979), the Southminster Foundation has distributed over \$900,000 to Community Outreach Grants and to the Southminster Fund
- The current Foundation Investment portfolio is over \$941,000
- Grants are aimed at addressing poverty, food, medical care, domestic violence, and affordable housing
- In 2023 the Foundation distributed \$29,000 in Grants to Community Outreach and to the Southminster Church Fund
